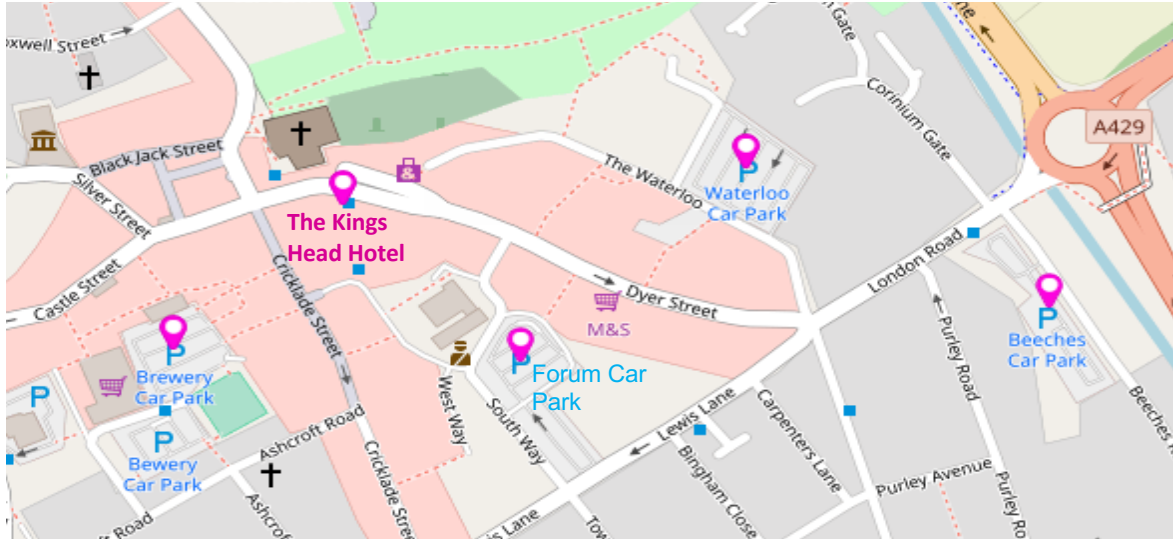


KINGS·HEAD

PUBLIC CAR PARK DIRECTIONS



1. Waterloo Car Park (GL7 2PY)

- Head east on Market Place which leads into Dyer Street
- Turn left at traffic lights onto The Waterloo
- Turn right into the car park

Charges: Mon- Sat 8.00am – 6.00pm /
Sun 10.00am – 6.00pm. Location: 804758

£9.20 - 10hrs Free overnight

**Shortcut to hotel on foot: turn right out of car park, walk past library into alleyway, exits into Market Place.*

2. The Beeches Car Park (GL7 1BW)

- Head east on Market Place which leads into Dyer Street
- At traffic lights, continue onto London Road
- Turn next right into Beeches Road
- Turn right into the car park

Charges: Mon- Sat 8.00am – 6.00pm /
Sun 10.00am – 6.00pm. Location: 804759

£3.10 - 10hrs Free overnight

Can pay for up to 6 days in advance

3. The Forum Car Park (GL7 1FN)

- Head east on Market Place
- Turn right after The Bear onto North Way
- Follow the road into South Way
- Turn left into the car park

Charges Mon- Sat 8.00am – 6.00pm /
Sun 10.00am – 6.00pm. Location: 804753

£4.60 - 3hrs Free overnight

Can purchase ticket the day before

4. The Brewery Car Park (GL7 1HN)

- Head east on Market Place
- Turn right after The Bear onto North Way
- Follow road into South Way
- Turn right onto Lewis Lane
- At traffic lights, continue onto Querns Lane
- Turn right into Ashcroft Gardens
- Turn left onto Ashcroft Road
- Turn right onto Cripps Road
- Follow road into car park (beside Tesco's)

Charges: Mon- Sat 8.00am – 6.00pm /
Sun 10.00am – 6.00pm. Location: 804752

£4.60 - 3hrs Free overnight

With MiPermit (at supported car parks) you can pay for your parking in Cirencester without paying in cash or needing to display a physical ticket on your vehicle.

NB Disabled Badge Holders may park free all day at these car parks, except at the Brewery where it is a maximum of 3 hrs
